

Terms and rules.

Our goal is to provide opportunities for the development of consistently profitable traders.

Our rules aim not only to limit our risks, but also to build a specific path for the growth of a successful person. By agreeing to our policies, you represent that you are at least eighteen (18) years of age and of sound mind, and that you are capable of agreeing to and complying with the terms and conditions contained in this Agreement. If you are using our offerings on behalf of an entity or other third party, you represent that you have the actual authority to act as that entity's or third party's agent, and that you have the right and ability to agree to the terms of this Agreement and to bind that third party or entity to them on its behalf.

Attention: the conditions in the challenge test are different from those that you will receive on real accounts. There are much stricter rules for risk management within the company. In the challenge we give you more opportunities!!!

You represent that your use of our products does not violate any law, regulation, ordinance, statute or treaty that is applicable to persons or entities located in the jurisdiction in which you reside. You further represent that you are not prohibited from entering into this Agreement by the terms of any pre-existing agreement.

We welcome feedback and continually evaluate the effectiveness of the rules along with the overall performance of the trader; however, it is ultimately the responsibility of the Participant to adapt strategy and trading style to the specific rules as currently defined.

It is the participant's responsibility to understand basic trading concepts, the unique characteristics of the stock markets, and the specific venue and platform used in testing and trading.

In particular, in relation to trading, the User must be fully familiar with the following terms and their implications: Market Hours, Economic Releases, Spreads, Commissions, Slippage, Variable Spread Terms, Volatility, Cents, Point Value, Share Size, Stop Loss, Quantity, Take Profit, Market Order, Stop Order, Limit Order, Ask, Bid, Daily Risk, Trailing Drawdown, Daily loss, etc.

Procedure for payment and testing.

After payment, the company undertakes to open a demo account for the participant within 3 business days. The trial period begins the next business day after the participant receives an email with the account login and password. Keep in mind we do not have automatic subscription renewal, if you want to extend the trial you will need to notify the manager and do it manually. Also pay attention! Money deposited into the subscriber account cannot be frozen and cannot be returned!

Basic program structure

Starting the test after passing the stage of personalization and evaluation of strategies, the Participant receives a demo account, in which the Participant is expected to demonstrate consistently profitable trading activity, which gives him the opportunity to get a real trading account.

Grade

To receive a real account, the Participant must:

1. Execute a program task
2. Do not violate the established restrictions and program rules.

Review

Once the targets are achieved, the risk department will review your trades within 3-5 business days to ensure they comply with other rules and are compatible with the risk model. You may also be asked to provide identification documentation to comply with anti-money laundering regulations. We will open an account to everyone who has fulfilled the goal, but only those who fulfill all the requirements and pass the interview will be able to become part of the company's team.

You may be invited to a video interview; This is a chance for us to get to know you as a trader and discuss your trading style and experience with the program on a more holistic basis. The recorded interview may be retained to ensure quality, compliance and other issues, as well as to include traders' feedback.

Funded account.

After receiving financing, each time you meet the criteria, we will increase your purchasing power and risk, total margin according to the terms of the trader elevator.

Volatility rules.

- During the relevant trading cessation, no active trading is permitted.
 - *Cessation of trading includes any of the following:*
 - Pause trading on a specific symbol for any reason
 - Automatic shutdown in the entire market or any other failure in trading on the exchange or in the entire market
 - Any condition disrupting the fair and orderly market, for this symbol or the market generally, which may be announced in advance or at a time in the sole discretion of our risk management.

- Any condition under which the trading system displays a symbol as non-tradable
- For purposes of this section, each symbol affected by such a stop is designated as a stopped symbol, and the position (actual or potential) on any such symbol is designated as a stopped position.
- For the purposes of this section, active trading includes any of the following:
 - Execution of any order on a stopped symbol
(Note: execution of such orders during a technically implemented stop is generally not possible, but in the event that the system inadvertently attempts to record such execution, the company's risk management department reserves the right to cancel or delete the trade in question)
 - Placing an order to open or add to a stopped position
- If a stop occurs, once trading is resumed, the trader must wait 1 minute before opening or adding a position on the affected symbol.
 - There are no exceptions to this rule.
- It is the user's responsibility to be aware of possible stoppages and to manage open positions and orders accordingly.
 - The symbol may be automatically stopped without prior notice after the asset changes by 10% within 5 normal trading minutes.
 - Users should familiarize themselves with the regulation and trading stoppage rules of the exchange (e.g., Nasdaq LULD). [Nasdaq LULD](#)
- Opening or adding a position is not allowed on a symbol that has made an 8% move within 4 regular trading minutes (volatility measurement period, described in more detail below) in the direction of the move.
 - This rule applies regardless of whether any suspension has actually been imposed on the asset.
 - The volatility measurement period covers the last 240.0 regular trading seconds on a rolling basis (at the time of trade entry), limited to the current trading session and excluding:
 - Any stopping period for a symbol
 - Extended trading hours
 - In particular, it is prohibited to open or add by price
 - greater than or equal to 1.08 from the minimum execution price for long positions; or
 - less than or equal to 0.92 of the maximum strike price, for short positions

during the volatility measurement period, in accordance with the execution prices indicated on the trading platform.

Note: it is allowed to do this on a pullback within an 8% move; provided, however, that the range specified by this calculation shall not be violated.

Consistency Rule/30% Rule

- The maximum position profit ratio is 30% unless otherwise stated; that is, the User's best position cannot be responsible for more than 30% (or an appropriate ratio) of the total actual profit. This applies to all assessments, as well as payouts and scalings from those funded accounts with this rule.
 - For valuation accounts, the User must close out each position using pending limit orders or other appropriate mechanisms until that amount is achieved relative to the target profit (original or adjusted; see below).

- **Note:**

This is ideal as it demonstrates the discipline the Company is looking for and makes it easier for the User to evaluate, but is not mandatory.

- The User must earn sufficient total profit that the ratio is not exceeded by any position held relative to the total profit, regardless of whether any position's profit exceeds the ratio relative to the target profit.
 - The smallest amount of profit that allows this condition to be met for all valid trades is the adjusted target profit.
 - The Company may provide the User with the option to remove all profits from a position whose profits exceed this threshold, allowing the User to continue working toward achieving the original profit goal.
 - Once the original profit target is met, the User may appeal this requirement for any positions affected by unexpected gaps such as between sessions and outages. The Company is under no obligation to consider or grant any such appeals.
 - Some account types impose a minimum number of profitable days in the payout cycle.
 - In order for the profit on any position to count, the following distance and duration requirements must be met:
 - Each position must generate at least 10 price ticks of profit (that is, the difference of 10.0 cents between the average entry price and the average exit price).

Example: buy at \$50.10, sell at \$50.20 (at least).

- There must be an interval of at least 60.0 seconds between each open/add execution and the next subsequent close/reduce execution during the life of that position.
- **Note: All rules associated with “positions” apply to any profit for the entire life of any position (i.e. from the moment the trade was opened until “zero”).**

Risk management

We require all participants to trade under established risk management discipline. Monitor risks, stops and maximum account drawdown! If you are losing and have reached the total minus value = max trailing loss, then your test has failed and you can start again only by purchasing the challenge again.

Copying/laundrying transactions

Copy trading is defined as entering any position within 30 minutes of entering the same position in another account, regardless of entry size or price.

Wash trading is defined as entering any position within 30 minutes of entering an opposing position on another account, regardless of entry size or price. Wash trading is prohibited.

Frequently placing limit orders during the test may be considered trading fraud

Economic Events Releases

When any economic data is released, price tends to form gaps and spreads can widen several times and execution is not guaranteed by price. It is recommended to pay attention to the event release schedule to reduce position exposure and move limit and stop orders further.

Trading gaps

During periods of extreme liquidity in the market, the difference between one tick quote and the next can widen significantly. This is also known as "rupture". Any orders placed at prices without a tick quote will be executed at the next available quote. This may result in execution at a less than preferred price.

Incorrect operation of stop order

Placing an order at a specially requested price is not a function of stop orders - once triggered, the price will be filled at the next best price according to the exchange's order book.

Stock Market Trading Hours

Market hours are based on the ET time zone. On normal days, the stock market opening hours are from 09:30 to 16:00, Monday to Friday.

However, during the US holidays the market will close early or not be active at all.

It is the user's responsibility to check and know holidays, days and hours of activity.

Complaints and disputes
